

interestingly, she said that you have been great to deal with lately and if that remains the case, things will be fine; she's heard so-called horror stories about your temper and doesn't want to deal with that; I explained that you told me you are more interested in mentoring people such as Kim and me, and that it is happening, right now; she had to run and I told her I want to keep the dialogue open, every day if necessary, until she's comfortable about her future here; her greatest fear is that Near North may fold and that she made the wrong choice by staying;
I'm also fairly certain that money is not her primary motivation; she needs to feel comfortable and supported;
I personally told her that she is exceptionally talented and has my full support and that of Mike Segal;
I relayed your line to me about choosing between losing her and keeping Sony (i.e. you choose her); and
I explained that I worked at Marsh and it is not nearly as exciting nor does one get a look at serious opportunities for growth as one does here, i.e., you don't have to pay your dues for ten years if you are doing the job right now.

Bottom line: she wants and intends to stay (she said that to me) but needs assurances that we're not going broke, out of business, did something criminal, etc.

# DECLARATION OF DAVID GROSSMAN

David Grossman, declaring under penalty of perjury, attests to the following:

- I am the Managing Director of Pinkerton Consulting and Investigations, Inc., ("Pinkerton"). Pinkerton provides professional consulting and investigative services to a wide range of public and private companies, individuals, and government agencies.
- 2. Prior to my employment at Pinkerton, I served for 21 years with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Among other positions at the FBI, I served as Supervisor of the Public Corruption Squad, and later, as Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the Chicago Field Office of the FBI.
- 3. On approximately April 18, 2002, Pinkerton was retained through counsel for Near North Insurance Brokerage ("NNIB") and Michael Segal to consult on an investigation of an extensive and complex backing scheme into the computer network system at NNIB.
- 4. Between approximately May 8 and May 21, 2002, I had several telephonic conferences with FBI Supervisory Special Agent Robert Shields ("SSA Shields"), Supervisor of the Cybertrime Squad for the Chicago Field Office of the FBI, regarding the government's investigation of unauthorized hacking into NNIB's systems.

5. On May 21, 2002, I met face-to-face with SSA Shields to discuss the status of the government's investigation of the hacking of NNIB's systems. Over the course of my telephonic and face-to-face meetings with the FBI from May 8 through May 21, 2002, SSA Shields advised me that the government was aware of the unauthorized computer hacking activity at NNIB, and that by May 21, 2002, the government had "opened a file" with respect to the hacking scheme at NNIB. Among other issues we discussed, SSA Shields also advised me that the FBI would need to "run things by" AUSA James Conway, the attorney supervising the investigation, and that NNIB would need to establish that it suffered a minimum of \$5,000.00 in losses from the hacking intrusion to reach the federal jurisdictional threshold for purposes of the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act.

DAVID KENNETH CHELEY, date of birth 01/01/1971, SSAN 112-76-7825, 222 E. Pearson, #2706, Chicago, Illinois, residence telephone number 312-988-7774, cellular telephone number 312-933-8814, was interviewed at the Lake Forest Oasis, Interstate 94, Lake Forest, Illinois. After being advised of the identities of the interviewing agents and the nature of the interview, CHELEY provided the following information:

CHELEY was asked if he knew the reason why the agents wanted to speak with him. CHELEY stated he could guess the reason and that it probably had something to do with NEAR NORTH, aka NEAR NORTH INSURANCE BROKERAGE, hereafter known as NNIB.

CHELEY stated he first began working at NNIB as a consultant approximately three to four years ago. CHELEY stated he came to work at NNIB through a company called SMARTSOURCE as a contract employee. CHELEY stated he was given the option after six months to continue his association with SMARTSOURCE or to become an independent contractor. CHELEY stated he chose to become an independent contractor.

CHELEY stated he initially worked in the Benefits
Department at NNIB as a technical consultant. CHELEY stated he was
hired to implement on-line benefit enrollment systems. CHELEY
stated a few months prior to leaving NNIB he was hired as permanent
employee in NNIB's Information Technology (IT) Department. CHELEY
stated he completed tasks related to programming, network
administration, and network security. CHELEY stated he was
terminated by NNIB in October 2001. CHELEY stated NNIB personnel
told him he was being terminated due to financial reductions.

CHELEY stated while employed in NNIB's IT Department he had domain level administrative access. CHELEY stated he was able to provide network access to new NNIB employees and was responsible for setting up new accounts. CHELEY stated a new employees's account was issued with a generic password which the employee had to change during their first login session to NNIB's network. CHELEY stated he could also reset and change passwords.

CHELEY stated NNIB's network implements the Microsoft Windows 2000/NT operating system. CHELEY stated he suspects the system was not always fully patched with security patches provided by Microsoft but that he himself was not responsible for applying security patches to the network. CHELEY stated an individual named RALPH TARANTINO was in charge of patching the network but that TARANTINO is no longer employed by NNIB. CHELEY stated when he left NNIB an individual named TONY Last Name Unknown was acting as the IT Director for NNIB.

CHELEY stated NNIB had approximately a dozen servers that he was aware of at their downtown Chicago location. CHELEY stated while employed at NNIB he had domain level administrative access to all of NNIB's servers for administrative purposes. CHELEY stated he did not have access to the SUN Microsystems (SUN) servers operated by NNIB. CHELEY stated approximately four to five servers were web servers, one server was for payroll, approximately three servers were application servers and approximately three servers were application servers where employees could store their work product. CHELEY stated all employee e-mail would be stored on one of the

CHELEY stated an individual could access some areas of NNIB's network from the Internet. CHELEY stated NNIB's internal network may or may not be secure from external access depending on what part of the system an individual was trying to access. CHELEY stated for some parts of the system an individual would need physical access to the system to be able to compromise it.

CHELEY stated employee log-in identifications are linked so that an employee can use the same network ID for both internal and external access to NNIB's network. CHELEY stated the ID and password must be stored and configured in different places on the network for authentication purposes. CHELEY stated despite having domain level administrative access to NNIB's network he would have to go through the authentication process like any other employee to access the NNIB internal network from the Internet

CHELEY stated there is one main telephone access number to access NNIB's network. CHELEY stated a router routes the telephone connection through a randomly assigned number to the NNIB network in order to free up the main telephone access number.

CHELEY stated there was no set process in place in the IT Department at NNIB for when an employee left NNIB's employment.

CHELEY stated he was not in charge of this process but that they were working on setting up an exit process regarding network access and IT issues when he was leaving the company. CHELEY stated he was aware that individuals who had left NNIB's employment continued to access NNIB's network.

CHELEY stated he has a wireless network at his residence and a Sprint Broadband Wireless Internet Connection bearing a static Internet Protocol (IP) address. CHELEY stated his IP address was recently changed due to the fact someone was hacking his IP address. CHELEY stated when he installed the network he did not apply the proper encryption and discovered that an unknown individual was surfing the Internet through his network.

CHELEY stated this unauthorized activity occurred over approximately a four month period from January 2002 through mid-May 2002. CHELEY stated he recently installed a proxy, or firewall, on his system as well as changing his IP address.

After displaying several IP logs provided by KEMPER and NNIB to CHELEY, he identified his home office telephone number of "312-988-9608" on the log files. CHELEY also identified his former Sprint Broadband IP address of "66.1.214.97" on the log files. CHELEY stated it could have been possible that he attempted to access his old account at NNIB to see if it was still active. CHELEY was then asked specifically why he logged into NNIB's network on 04/11/2002 and 04/19/2002. CHELEY stated again he was checking to see if his old NNIB account was still active.

CHELEY was asked specifically why he accessed NNIB's network numerous times from August 2001 through April 2002. CHELEY admitted he accessed NNIB's network initially because he could easily attain access to their system. CHELEY stated he kept checking NNIB's system to see if his old NNIB account was active and eventually began "looking around the system to see if it was locked down." CHELEY stated he held no animosity for NNIB. CHELEY stated NNIB even provided him with a severance package when they terminated his employment.

CHELEY stated he accessed NNIB's network for two reasons. CHELEY stated the first reason was that he wanted to check the status of NNIB's IT personnel. CHELEY stated the second reason was that he wanted to know what was going on at NNIB following the federal indictments. CHELEY stated he wanted to see if the IT Department had the "smarts" to lock down their network. CHELEY

stated after discovering the system was not secured he intended to write a letter to MICHAEL SEGAL informing him of the matter and the failure of the IT Department. CHRLEY stated it was never his intention to cause any harm to NNIB or to pass any information he gained from accessing NNIB's network to any individuals or companies.

CHELEY stated because of the high level of administrative access to NNIB's network that he was given while employed at NNIB, he was able to gain continued access to the network through other employee's accounts. CHELEY stated a web based table stored on the NNIB network contains individual employee's names and their system passwords in plain text. CHELEY stated the passwords were not encrypted.

CHELEY stated while accessing NNIB's network he read email messages belonging to upper management personnel and those pertaining to NNIB's IT Department. The interviewing agents informed CHELEY the log files in their possession indicated on multiple occasions CHELEY accessed the e-mail accounts of at least eight different individuals employed at NNIB and often for extensive periods of time. CHELEY stated he did read e-mail messages belonging to TONY SWIANTEK, MICHAEL SEGAL, KAREN GRUCA and JOY SEGAL. CHELEY stated he did not read e-mail messages belonging to BRUCE WOLL, JON SEGAL, LEE JACKSON and PERNILLE KJOLBY. CHELEY stated two of these individuals have left NNIB and since become employed by AON.

CHELEY was asked about the content of the e-mail messages he read. CHELEY stated he "did not find anything" of specific interest. CHELEY stated he would often access NNIB's network during down times while compiling software. CHELEY stated he knows that he "did something wrong", meaning his accessing of NNIB's network.

CHELEY stated he never provided any information he obtained while accessing NNIB's network to any other individuals or companies. CHELEY stated he did not save or copy any of the information he accessed to his computer or to any type of recordable media. CHELEY stated there is no reason why anyone would state he provided them with information regarding NNIB. CHELEY stated every conversation he had with various individuals regarding NNIB stemmed only from information gained from local news coverage.

CHELEY was shown a copy of a written statement admitting his accessing of NNIB's network from IP addresses assigned to KEMPER INSURANCE. The statement was provided by KROLL INC. to KEMPER INSURANCE. KROLL INC. is a risk consulting company that examined the KEMPER computer system for possible security compromises.

CHELEY read the document and stated the signature on the last page was in fact his signature. After reading the statement, CHELEY referred to the document and stated "That's the truth". CHELEY stated he has never before accessed someone else's network without authorization prior to these incidents involving NNIB's network. CHELEY stated has never hacked a computer system.

CHELEY stated he has a website called <a href="https://www.aboutdave.com">www.aboutdave.com</a>
that is hosted by HOSTWAY COMMUNICATIONS. CHELEY stated this
website was hacked and the log files indicated the IP address was
assigned to NNIB. CHELEY stated the hacker changed some wording on
his resume that was posted on the site and added some derogatory
words aimed at CHELEY. CHELEY stated the hack occurred in late
April 2002. CHELEY stated in response he wrote two lines of code
that redirected any IP addresses assigned to NNIB, which attempted
to access his website, to an FBI website.

CHELEY stated at home he has a server which runs his firewall and also hosts two web sites. These web sites are called <a href="https://www.cheley.net">www.cheley.net</a> and <a href="https://www.license71.com">www.license71.com</a>. CHELEY stated he also has his laptop computer and that his wife has her own computer. CHELEY stated he used his laptop computer to access NNIB's network from home. CHELEY stated he used his laptop and various KEMPER INSURANCE computer's to access NNIB's network while employed at KEMPER INSURANCE.

CHELEY stated he is currently employed by a company called ALLSCRIPTS. CHELEY stated the company is in the medical software business and is located in Libertyville, Illinois. CHELEY stated he uses JAVA-based and Microsoft Windows-based applications in his current employment. CHELEY stated he programs in JAVA, Visual Basic, C++, HTML and XML computer languages

CHELEY stated after leaving NNIB's employment he began working at KEMPER INSURANCE. CHELEY stated he had no administrative access other than normal user access to KEMPER's network. CHELEY stated while at KEMPER INSURANCE he was contracted through DHS CONSULTING. CHELEY stated after being terminated by KEMPER

INSURANCE in April 2002 due to his accessing of NNIB's network from their location, DHS never contacted him again. CHELEY stated he has not attempted to gain access to NNIB's network since being terminated by KEMPER INSURANCE.

CHELEY was asked by the interviewing agents about a password cracking program called LOPHT CRACK that was found on his assigned NNIB computer by NNIB IT Department personnel. CHELEY stated he obtained that program via a download from the Internet to be used as an administrative tool by NNIB IT Department personnel to obtain lost passwords on NNIB's system. CHELEY stated a former systems administrator employed by NNIB had left the company without revealing passwords and the IT personnel had to crack the system using LOPHT CRACK to implement new passwords.

CHELEY was provided with a Grand Jury subpoena to provide any computer and/or laptop computers to the U.S. Attorney's Office via the interviewing agents. CHELEY was also provided with an FD-26 Consent to Search form. CHELEY agreed to comply with the subpoena by providing the laptop computer to the interviewing agents.
